



<b>Abbreviated name</b>	Completeness of reporting by facilities
<b>Indicator name</b>	Completeness of reporting by facilities
<b>Domain</b>	Health systems
<b>Subdomain</b>	HSS
<b>Associated terms</b>	Health information
<b>Definition</b>	Percentage of facilities that submit reports within the required deadline.
<b>Numerator</b>	Number of facilities reporting monthly within a given time period.
<b>Denominator</b>	Total facilities.
<b>Disaggregation/ additional dimension</b>	Facility type, geographic location, managing authority, programme
<b>Method of measurement</b>	The number of reports received from facilities (usually monthly) is divided by the expected number of reports from facilities. Districts also report on a monthly or quarterly basis to national levels, and the received number of reports can be related to the expected number in order to assess completeness.

<b>Measurement frequency</b>	Annual (monthly)
<b>Monitoring and evaluation framework</b>	Input
<b>Preferred data sources</b>	Routine facility information systems
