September SRG – Action Steps

To the Stakeholders:

- Decide: Use the SDG3 GAP Heat Map to measure progress on alignment
- Provide feedback on and potentially approve:
 - Evaluation TORs (by November SRG)
 - ToRs for regional support (by November SRG)
 - 2022-25 work plan
 - Comms and advocacy strategy (including call for volunteers to refine and implement)
- Need to fund resources at the WG level (e.g. RHIS repository (need for resources to be actively managed) and DDG (highlight good practices of data governance)) – WG co-chairs to share with the Secretariat their funding needs and/or simply add those directly to their workplans/TORs
- Suggestion: Secretariat to set up ad hoc calls to keep track of the action points above: TOR, Comms and Advocacy, etc

September SRG – Action Steps

To the HDC Secretariat:

Session 1

- Takeaway for HDC: reflect on how do we facilitate a platform for engagement of private sector CSO?

Session 2

- Measure the status of alignment among HDC countries and non-HDC countries to see if there is a difference
- Resources mapping: look at money flows and map out opportunities to know where the needs for coordination and alignment are, and for leveraging knowledge assets and scaling up country impact – to make sure there is more efficiency on what donors and partners are doing in the country
- To steer mission outputs/conclusion/follow-up so we have an investment case made by a combination of Gov't and partners at the end of missions

Session 3

- Clean up the HDC membership list
- HDC Secretariat to pick up on the WGs deliverables monitoring work
- What's HDC elevator's pitch? + Toolkit: one-pagers; success cases info-sheets; country stories
- HDC Secretariat to steer value proposition clarity from each WG to countries and vice-versa
- Think about concrete strategies for fostering more collaboration and cross-cutting work between different WGs and disseminating products across WGs

September SRG – Action Steps

To the HDC Secretariat:

Session 4

- Missing capacity building for data analytics and use – consider adding this to the technical items of focus
- “Network of networks” – we need a collaborative at the regional/country level – or a mirror of the collaborative below the global level -> helping countries to manage the collaboration at the country level

Session 5

- Knowledge Hub: for a few documents, they are with the file’s titles, not with the actual documents’ titles – that change will need to be done manually
- Work with Owen on the feedback to be received from stakeholders

September SRG – Action Steps

To the HDC Secretariat:

Session 6

- Co-creation of questionnaire for HDC evaluation (ensuring country input and taking a country lens) + share progress of the evaluation on the website (transparency)
- Creative solutions for communication: email is no longer viable communication tool standing alone – we should have slack/alternative channels – WhatsApp? – need to think of more casual communication
- How co-chairs mentor the next co-chair? It is good to have an SOP for these things
- HDC evaluation: the questions for the company that will do the evaluation should have been received before so they can be included in the TOR for this company – but certainly we can have an external panel for co-creation with the company (Secretariat to ensure this external panel is possible)
- We need to evaluate and monitor if countries who already interacted with the HDC are doing better than the ones not engaging with the HDC – can the Secretariat help here?
- Theory of change slide: it is too green, hard to read
- Mid-point indicators: think about enhancing evaluation, how to make those points more meaningful?

Session 7

- Ask the stakeholders to send us documents to create a repository on investing in data systems
- Invitation to panel: the SRG will have 3 opportunities to offer inputs; we want to ensure they have oversight and that they will be able to guide the people producing this investment case
