HDC 2020-21: successes & opportunities

1. HDC membership, diversity & interest increasing:

11 country (MoHs / NSOs), 16 CSOs, 26 GHIs,
15 multilaterals, 39 Research, Academia and Tech Networks,
12 Private Sector, 15 Donors / Foundations.

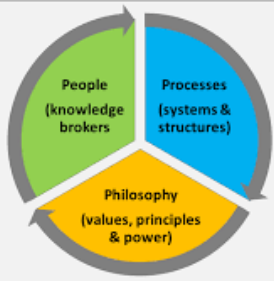
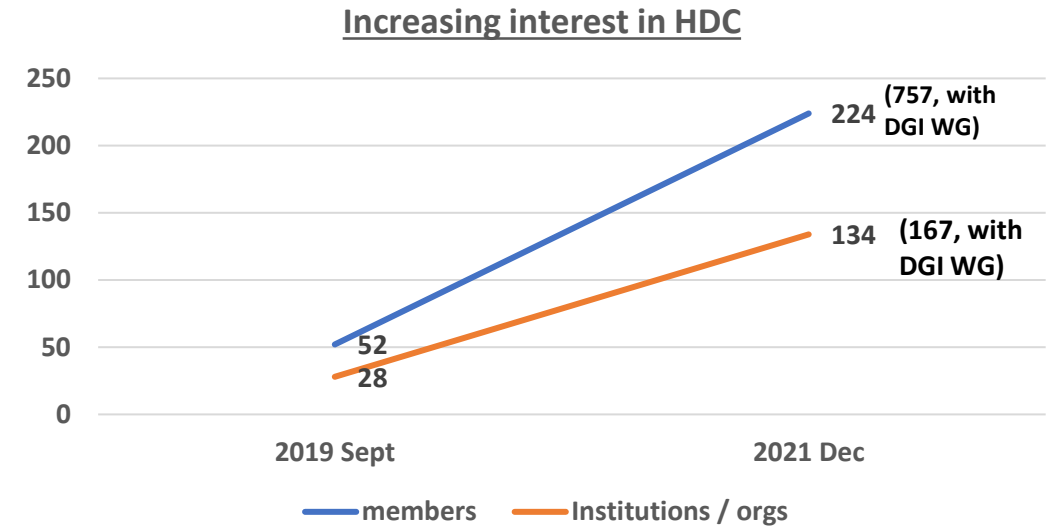


2. Stronger multilateral cooperation:

- SDG GAP data & digital (co-chaired UNFPA / WHO) / regional / country teams
- Connections to UN SG data strategy and UNDESA SDG monitoring group

3. Knowledge brokering:

- 10 HDC hosted events for technical tools / good practices / new work in 2021
- Redesigning website platform (based on feedback)
- 4 GPG meets 2020-2021, 1 leadership meet 2020, Data Governance Summit 2021

5. Country and Regional driven approaches:

- 5 countries prioritized data needs next 2 years (Govt. led)
- Country updates and coordination mechanisms
- Move towards regional coordination & institution capacity building

6. Seven functioning HDC working groups ‘technical engines’:

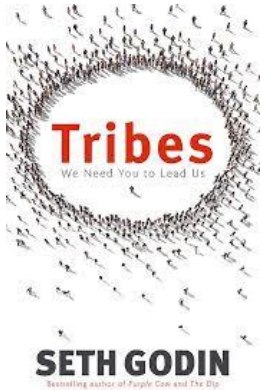
- CRVS, RHIS, DIO, LMIS, D&DG, PHI & Community Data

- 2021>systematic planning, input to agendas & implementation of WGs
- SRG, co-chair & WG chairs



HDC 2020-21: challenges to overcome



1. Constituency-based representation:

- Representation, ability to engage
- >support for CSO, countries, RATs & private sector
- Access to SRG



2. Managing expectations:

- Prioritizing & identifying gaps generates expectations (\$, tech.)
- HDC shining light on gaps - ensuring HDC partners engage (investment case)
- Secretariat 1.5 people



3. Proof of concept for country impact:

- 3 steps – partners need to change behaviour to align with country priorities
- 5 country priorities publicly available = ‘chicken and egg’

HDC 2020-21: challenges to overcome (cont.)



4. Aligning digital health and data:

- Identifying common space in digital health with data
- Large DIO WG resource and experiences



5. Clear consistent communications:

- Advocacy for common data agenda
- Use of HDC partner comms and advocacy



6. Scaling up HDC approach with country impact:

- Trust and in country team liaison and relationships
- Regional Institutes, partners, Ros for advocacy, tech support & capacity building
