WORKING GROUP Challenges

- ▶ In-country implementation
 - ▶ Country and regional dissemination of global goods and project implementation stalled due to the COVID-19 pandemic
 - ▶ Need to strengthen communication with countries and partners
 - ▶ Need for managing expectations for resources to implement projects in-country
 - ▶ Need for additional and sustainable financial/human resources to carry out the implementation of projects in countries
- ▶ Working Groups
 - ▶ Need to considerably increase country membership and engagement in most Working Groups
 - ▶ Lack of coordination and communication sometimes results inequality of work quality, especially when countries are less involved.
 - ▶ Need to increase diversity and partners voices, especially from constituencies under-represented in Working Groups
 - ▶ Need to have clearer deliverable timelines and meeting management for working groups
 - ▶ Need to strengthen cross-work between working groups
